The Memory Project seeks to create an environment for reflection, contemplation and interaction with the subject of collective and individual memory within a specifically created installation and time structure.

'The Memory Project' links electronic media with history and art.

The visitor encounters a microcosm of information, presented in contrasting mediums and with interacting content within a precise ritualistic time frame without beginning or end. Fragments of historical and contemporary biographical data are framed within a discussion on the nature of archiving and collection: what do we search for in the past; how do we find it; what do we want to keep from it; and how are these fragments from the past related to us today.

The processes and multiple pathways of information storage, whether in the form of a library, archive, or museum; as well as in the digital form of a database network, are made transparent to the public.

By participating in and interacting within this information and retrieval storage network, the Visitor experiences a confrontation with the forms in which the keys to our identity and memory are stored outside ourselves by institutions and hired professionals.

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
